Course Expectation:

Mandarin 1 is aiming to develop your Mandarin proficiency level based on the the American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages standards. It provides you a platform not only to approach the language elements, but also to see the world from a different perspective. This course emphasizes both your language skills and your global awareness. The goal of this year is to make you more confident to carry on real life tasks by using Mandarin.

Grading Policy:

Your grade will be based on your homework, participation, project and quizzes/tests points. Final grade is determined by adding the total points earned on total points assigned.

- ♦ **Homework**: 1-3 points, completion grade. For unexcused late work, half points.
- Participation: 20 points, twice for each term. Depending on your in-class effort, frequency of participation and efforts to use Mandarin. (See the participation rubric for details)
- Projects: 10-40 points, depending on the length and requirements. For unexcused late work, half points.
- ♦ Quizzes/tests: 1-40 points, depending on the length and requirements.
